Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.







- 1. Remove the passenger seat as shown.




- 2. Remove the caps from the right grab rail as shown.
 - Repeat on the left side.






Remove the left side cover as shown.

- 7. Temporarily assemble the left saddlebag stay to the left saddlebag bracket as shown.





8. Align each hole in the left saddlebag bracket with each hole in the left grab rail as shown.



INSTALLATION <Single-seater> ACAUTION


- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory. NOTE:
- The Saddlebag mounting bracket (single seat) is required for installation of this accessory.
- For a motorcycle equipped with the Rear Fender Lid, remove the attachment before installing this accessory.
- Steps 9 through 16 are applicable only to a motorcycle equipped with the Rear Fender Lid.
- 1. Remove the passenger seat as shown.






3. Remove the stay from the main seat as shown.




4. Remove the right and left grab rails as shown.
















- 14. Install the original-equipment right rear fender lid as shown.




15. Install the rear fender in the reverse order of removal.




17. Temporarily assemble the left saddlebag stay as shown.
